

## **Retouching Your Original Lettering**

## Supply List

(U.S. and Canadian residents: John Neal Bookseller has most of these supplies.)

- Pieces you want to retouch
- Whatever ink or fluid you use for your lettering
- Stiff pointed nibs—Use whatever you have, but here are a few suggestions if you need them: Vintage Esterbrook #788 Oval Point (my nib of choice); Gillott 291; Nikko G; Hunt 513EF
- Nib holder
- OPTIONAL: Nice pointed watercolor brush such as Winsor & Newton Series 7, Pointed Round Size 1 if you have larger areas to retouch. You could also use a 1/8" flat brush for larger areas.
- 6-well mixing palette
- Pencil and sharpener; OR mechanical pencil
- Ruler
- X-acto or scalpel with fresh #10 blade
- Bone folder
- Small scraps of paper that you used for your pieces
- Water container
- Rag or roll paper towels
- A few sheets of tracing paper
